The information in this book is of critical importance to the well being of the earth at this time. When you read this book you will understand on a deeper level what is actually happening to our climate, and you will discover the key to technology for resolving serious climate change issues we are currently facing and will face in the near and far future.

To date, I have published this book and have sent free copies out to some key people (Newspaper editors, CEOs, Professors,...etc) using funds lent to me by friends and from sales of my two books. It is urgent that I keep getting copies of this book into the hands of people around the world who can help with the climate change discoveries contained in it.

To date, alone I have donated my time and financial resources to bring these discoveries to the public, but that is not enough. I know that there is a lot more that needs to be done to bring my research to the right people and bring them together as a united team for the purpose of helping resolve the climate change issues through the scientific operation of the pyramids. I need your help in this important cause.

If you decide to support this important work, you will have a voice in how the resources are to be used. An international consortium or oversight committee will be formed for this purpose. The importance of spreading this information dictates the need to go worldwide to bring scientists together to work on this project.

Currently I have an established foundation called the "Classical Music for Children Foundation." My plan is to make the pyramid project a branch of that foundation for three reasons:

- 3. It will be important to the future of children of the world to resolve the climate issue as soon as we are able to.
